

According to the American Library Association the Newbery Medal is “named for eighteenth-century British bookseller John Newbery. It is awarded annually by the Association for Library Service to Children, a division of the American Library Association, to the author of the most distinguished contribution to American literature for children.”

While there is a Newbery Medal winner every year, the committee also selects honor books that are defined as being just as distinguished and treasured as the medal winner. A list of Honor book can be found online or you can ask your friendly Hudson librarians for help.

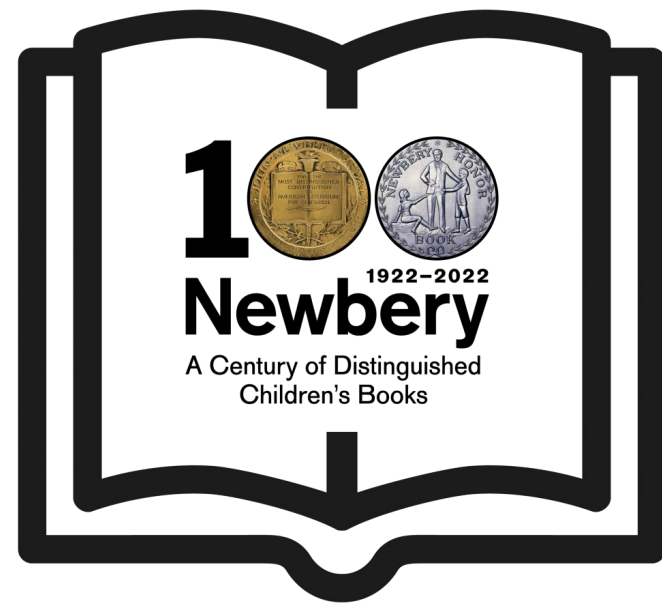
